Neurofibromatosis describes a group of 3 rare, genetic tumor predisposition syndromes: NF1, NF2 und Schwannomatosis. Non of these diseases have an EMA approved drug.

Patients with NF need early diagnosis, full information and consultation, and to be continuously provided with healthcare by an interdisciplinary team, under the supervision of a case-manager. NF patients must be under surveillance for their whole life and often need complimentary therapies.

The NF Kinder Center of expertise is a collaboration of the Austrian patient organization NF Kinder and the Medical University of Vienna. It was established in March 2018. Donations raised by NF Kinder allowed to build the necessary infrastructure to offer optimal support for pediatric patients with NF in Austria. It is the first NF specific medical institution for pediatric patients in Austria.

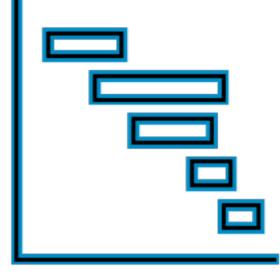
