- Lack of information, diagnosis, medical, social care and support for more than 700000, patients in Hungary
- Needed: medical, social, pedagogic, employment and psychological help

Offered solution

- 30 hr long group work with mentors and using innovative ideation practices such as design thinking to brainstorm on possible solutions.
- Explore insights on health innovation as a strategic drive for care provision.
- Help the care sector in further enhance the quality of health-, social- and other care services.
- Enable the brightest, national minds to create digital or other type of solutions, through emerging technologies in an innovation ecosystem, to enhance the quality of care services.
